# PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- Have sent out 56 Kindergarten 2018 acceptance letters. There were some parent's contacted re: no having received a place for 2018.
- This year, in conjunction with the Year 12 girls from St Joseph's, we are having 3 pop up playgrounds for the 2018 kindergarten children. These will be held in August 14, 24 & 28. This relates to the Year 12 Child Care Studies.
- Parents should have or will receive a letter from Peter Hamill re: free increase for 2018
- Staff Development Day: worked with Virginia Ryan, Father John and Mike Gaffney on Liturgy and developing a model of Governance for the school. This is our second session with Mike and we have another one on the 5<sup>th</sup> September.
- A governance model preview meeting for parents will be held on the evening of the 19<sup>th</sup> October
- A follow up meeting for parents who are selected to be involved in the St Patrick's School Governance will be held on the evening of the 9<sup>th</sup> November

Year 3 will have to complete omnibus only. All students will be doing NAPLAN online from 2018 or 2019. Important for parents to given children opportunities to use computer keyboards, especially for writing, maybe the Type quick APP. This year we will use iPads for the students to complete the trial

- Concert preparations are coming on nicely and we hope to have information out to parents re: costumes next week. WE have also organised different sound techs for this year in the hope that we will be able to hear the children
