Fr John Frauenfelder's Words of Wisdom...
Third Sunday of Lent – 4 March 2018

Drivers all know that a stop sign means stop. But, because we are clever at bending the law, we can soon convince ourselves

that if there's no police presence watching, and if we're in a hurry; it's OK merely to slow down.

In Sunday's first reading, the Ten Commandments are delivered to us. And, because we are clever, we start bending those commandments to fit our needs. For example: "If it's under a dollar in value, it is not really stealing." Or any of the other ways we sometimes stretch the commandments.

Some "rule twisters" may feel guilty when they hear the responsorial psalm: "The law of the Lord is perfect."
