

In Jesus' name we pray.




Belatedly I would like to wish all mums a Happy Mothers Day and trust that it was spent joyously with your families.

Dear Students and Parents,

The term so far has been very busy with lots of things happening at school. Last week our Year 6 students went to Canberra for 3 days. I have heard fantastic reports from many people about what a great time everyone had and how wonderfully the students behaved. Well done Year 6!!



This week has been a very hard one for Years 3 and 5 with the students completing their NAPLAN Assessments. The students were very tired by the time they had finished yesterday and all papers were posted yesterday.

Next week we have our Tier 2 (School Review) on Tuesday and Wednesday. There will be a panel of 7 people made up of CSO personnel and visiting Principals, who will spend the two days at school. During that time they will visit classrooms, meet with staff, students and parents as well as look through specific documentation. 


