FROM OUR PRINCIPAL......

Dear Parents and students,

It saddened me this week to hear that some of our parents had been discussing on social media, something that happened at school this week. At St Patrick's we have always encouraged parents to contact the school, especially the teacher first to seek clarification about any concerns they may have. There is always the avenue of making an appointment to meet with Miss Perry or myself if parents are not happy with the communication with the class teacher.

I can only continue to encourage parents to follow our protocol around communicating with the school, as using Social Media as a means of discussing things can result in legal proceedings for those involved.

On a happier note, last week's colour fun run was a great success with approximately \$6000.00 being raised, which will be used to purchase more 'Eddisons' for the students to use. These devices are used for 'coding' and the primary students that have been using them are very excited about them.



Technology Update

At the P & F Meeting I shared with the parents (unfortunately there was only a very small number of parents), what's happening in the Diocese and our school in regards to Technology. The CSO has managed a very good deal for schools to lease IPADS from next year at a reasonable cost. This means that St Patrick's will purchase/lease enough IPADS for each primary class to have one between



two students next year. This is a very significant cost to the school over the next two years. I am very grateful to the P & F for agreeing to support this initiative by paying half of the cost with the school for the next two years. This amounts to approximately \$16000.00 each year for two years.

As you can see this is a very significant cost and one that the school and the P & F cannot sustain each year. This means that in 2021, we will probably be going BYOD, starting with year 4 each year. Exactly what this looks like I am not sure, but we have two years to look into this and ensure that the process to move this way is thoroughly worked out.

Reports and Classes

School reports for Semester 2 will be emailed to parents on Friday 14th December. Also with this email you will find out the class teachers for each grade. On Monday 17th December, the students will have Step Up at 2pm. This is when your child will meet their teacher for 2019 and also find out the other students in their class.

I am very pleased to inform you that Ms Fiona Bolton will be the Acting REC for 2019, while Ms Fletcher is on secondment to St Brendan's. Ms Bolton brings a wealth of experience and knowledge to the role.

With Ms Fletcher at St Brendan's next year, we have appointed Miss Kaitlyn Crawford in a temporary full time position. Miss Crawford has worked part time at ST Patrick's over the past few years and we are very excited to have her working with us next year in a full time capacity.

End of year

Our last official last day for students is Tuesday 18th December. On this day we have Mass in the morning and the students are allowed to leave after Mass with their parents.

On Wednesday, there will be minimal supervision for students until the end of the day. School will be closed on Thursday and Friday.

Thank you Morning tea

Friday 14th December is our Special Assembly and thank you morning tea for all of our helpers. Morning tea will be at 10am followed by Assembly. We look forward to seeing many of our parent helpers at the morning tea.

The hope that promises that God is continually doing something new in us: In our hearts, our homes, our church, our world, and in our association.


Let us join together in praying and living this hope, And faithfully work toward the fulfilment of God's reign.

FROM YOUR ST PAT'S ADMIN LADIES............. An Update from Compass

Thank you to those parents who have logged in to Compass and embraced the new system. We have had many questions over the past few weeks of parents requesting their login details, asking for help with entering absence notes or having trouble opening attachments. We do value



your feedback. Please continue to let us know if you are unsure of anything as this is something that is new to us too.

A reminder that ALL communication (reminders, newsletters etc) to parents is now sent via Compass with some general information and reminders published on our School Facebook Page. If you have not received your login details, please contact the office as soon as possible as you will be missing out on important information.

To add an absence note for your child, please click on your child's photo and then click on 'Approvals'. You will see a plus sign at the bottom of the screen. Please use this to add your absence notes. You do not need to contact the school by telephone or email if you have added this note via Compass as this information feeds directly to the class roll for the teacher to see. Please be careful when selecting the times that your child is absent, if it a full day absence you do not need to change the times (they are automatically pre-set from 8:00am to 5:00pm). If you are dropping your child off late, you will need to enter the absence note leaving the start time as 8:00am and change the finish time to the time you dropped your child off ie 9:00am. If you are picking your child up early you will change the start time to the time of collection ie 12:00pm and you can leave the finish time at 5:00pm if your child is not returning to school that day.

If your child is marked 'Not Present' on the morning roll and an absence note has not been entered into Compass, you will receive a SMS notification around 10:00am. This SMS will have a link that will take you directly to the Compass App to enter the absence note for your child. Thank you for your prompt responses in entering these absences thus far.

All parents of children in Years 3-6 should be using Compass for late arrivals, early departures or full day absences. Parents of children in Years K-2 can use the Kiosk located in the office for late arrivals and early departures but should be using Compass for full day absences.

We have uploaded the Term 4 important dates into Compass. At this stage they can only be viewed on a desktop by clicking on the calendar icon or by clicking the 'open in browser' option on your mobile device (and then clicking on the calendar icon). We hope to have this information easily accessible on mobile devices soon. We have also entered some dates for 2019 including the Swimming Carnival, Cross Country and Athletics Carnival.

In 2019, Parent/Teacher Interviews will be booked via Compass, this includes the Maths Assessment Interviews (MAIs) that are undertaken on the first 2 days of the school year. More information will be sent home towards the end of this term with instructions on how to book a MAI for your child/ren.


