#### FROM OUR PRINCIPAL ...

Dear Parents and Carers,

This is our final newsletter for the term and as such I hope that when the holidays finally get here next week that you can all have a relaxing holiday after what has been for everyone another rather difficult term. COVID has resulted in many changes for all our families and their children and there have been many challenges for all of us. Let us all pray that as we move closer to the end of the year, that we see some light at the end of the tunnel.

#### First Reconciliation and Eucharist

Congratulations to all the children from the parish who received the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Wednesday night. The children began their journey earlier in the year and have been fortunate to complete their preparation and receive the sacrament for the first time.

Now over this Sunday and next Sunday these children will make their First Eucharist. The community will continue to keep them in our prayers as they take this important step in their Faith journey.

#### Year 6 End of Year Celebrations

We have been informed that our Year 6 Graduation Liturgy can go ahead on Thursday 3rd December. The date for Graduation Liturgy has been in the calendar on compass since the end of last year. At this stage I do not know what the liturgy and any school celebration after the liturgy will look like until the guidelines from the NSW Government and Catholic Schools Office have been given to schools.

#### **Year 1 and 2 Swimming Program**

Our Year 1 and 2 Swimming Program has been given the green light. We have been in contact with Gosford Pool and the CSO to ensure that the program is following COVID safe procedures.

#### **Swimming Carnival for 2021**

We have decided to have our swimming carnival for 2021 next term. There are a few reasons for this including that our sports captains this year have not had the usual opportunities. This will mean that from now on our Swimming Carnival for the following year will be held in Term 4 of the year before.

The Swimming Carnival as such will not be run the same way as earlier this year. We will go down as Year/Stage groups not as a whole school, this is to ensure we are meeting COVID guidelines. Once we have things organised we will inform parents.



#### **Kindergarten 2021 Transition**

The Kindergarten Transition Program we have held in previous years is not allowed to proceed in the same format, at the moment. We are waiting to find out if we can hold something and what this might look like. More information will be sent out to parents once we know more.

#### **Extra Kindergarten Class 2021**

We have had a significant number of enrolments for Kindergarten in 2021. As a result, we have been given an extra Kindergarten class. We are in discussions with the Catholic Schools Office as to how we can house this new class. We think we have a very good option, but I will let you know once I have this confirmed.

#### **Athletics Awards**

This term, as we were not able to hold our Athletics Carnival the Primary teachers have been taking the students down to the park to run the sprint races each week. I am most grateful for this as it means that we can award an Age Champion and Runner up. These sprints, although not under the usual athletics conditions, have been timed and results recorded. All the results will be collated to give us the successful students who will find out at our final assembly on Friday of Week 10.

Although this year has been very different, we wanted to try to award students as best we could.











#### **Public Speaking**

The grades have been working through their 'speeches' over the past few weeks. At our Assembly next Friday, the Grade Winner and Runner Up will be announced.

#### **Change to OOSH Hours**

After reviewing comments made in the survey sent to parents last term, I contacted Before and After School Care to see if they could apply to have their hours changed. We have some great news that from the beginning of Term 4 the operating hours will begin from 6:30am instead of 7:00am. I hope this is of benefit to our working families.


