



Counting Cats and Dogs


Directions: Count how many of each animal you see. Write the answers in the box provided below.

Toilet Roll Binoculars

What you will need:

Two toilet paper rolls or a kitchen towel roll cut in half - paint (or plain coloured paper) - PVA glue - ribbon

 If it is a sunny day, why not craft in the garden? Firstly choose your colours and paint your rolls. If you don't want to paint, you can cover your rolls in coloured paper – a bit like wrapping a present.

2) Once your paint is dry, glue on your ribbon (or staple it on) and then add the decorations. We used out clothes pegs to hold things in place whilst it dried.


3) Glue your two rolls together. Again, you may want to use clothes pegs to hold your rolls in place whilst it dries.

4) Add any remaining decorations such as stickers and let dry!

5) Now it's time to go on a Nature Scavenger Hunt. Can you find all the items on the next page of your booklet?




Feelings Chart

Instructions: Use this chart to help children label how they feel.








Colour the Rainbow fish
