A very big thank you to our 2022 School and Colour House Captains. They have been excellent student leaders and have set a high standard for next year's leaders to live up too.

The process for our captains starts during the Year 5 Leadership Camp and then later in the term with leadership activities at school. The Year 5 students nominate, vote and short list for the School Captains. Then the students in Years 2 – 5 vote after the short listed students present a 3 minute speech. The staff also vote. The Colour House Captain nominees present a 2 minute speech to the children from Year 2 – Year 5 in their colour. These children then vote for their Colour Captain.

School Closes for the year on Friday 16th December. Our formal lessons end tomorrow afternoon. On Wednesday we have some classes to move and there will be changes to where classes are in 2023.

Changes on the Infants side:

Downstairs will be the Infants Library, 2G and 2B. Upstairs will be KB, KG and KW then 1B and 1G with 2W at the end.

Changes on the Primary side:

Year 6 will be moving to the current Year 3 rooms and Year 3 will move to the current Year 6 rooms. Aspect Aqua K – 2 will be downstairs on the Primary side and Aqua 3 – 6 will be upstairs in their usual room.

We will have removalists at school on Wednesday morning to move the furniture that needs to be moved and personal things of the teachers who are moving classes. While things are being moved students will be supervised and then will move into the new spaces. It will be a little chaotic while these things are happening, so no formal lessons will take place after Tuesday. Teachers will spend Thursday and Friday settling into their new rooms as we do have quite a number of teachers moving rooms/ classes this year.

We have updated the calendar on Compass and all the dates we know have been entered. Please check these out especially if you are planning holidays etc.

Once again thank you for another wonderful year. I hope that everyone has a very Merry Christmas, a Happy New Year and a relaxing break over the holidays. And God permitting I will see you all in Term 2. God Bless
