## **Business from previous minutes**

#### **General Business Items**

- Whole school BBQ. Great attendance. Having one for the whole school was successful.
- Mother's Day breakfast. Time is good. Will look at alternatives to serve instead of a sausage sizzle.
- Athletics carnival to be held on June 9. P & F will open canteen for snacks and drinks.
- Easter raffle raised \$1600.
- Mother's Day raffle raised \$720.
- P & F are to spend some funds on rejuvenating the top playground. A \$20,000 limit has been agreed on. Looking at repainting the mural. P & F will meet with the SRC for feedback and other ideas from the students.
  - P & F to advice/update the school about funds raised and what they are spent on. Perhaps via a notice board on the playground.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Hand Uniform Shop. There seems to be some confusion in the school community about how this operates. Previously money has been spent on sports equipment and uniforms for sports teams when attending competitions and gala days. P & F has agreed to spend future funds on the Year 6 sports shirts.
  - Will look at a way to promote how the uniform shop helps the school. This will hopefully increase donations.

- Newsletter review. A survey has been sent out regarding the relevance of the newsletter. Some ideas suggested were to have an end of term newsletter with all the highlights and news from the term, continue with the weekly updates, and perhaps a start of term update advising of events that are scheduled for the upcoming term.
- School Disco 2<sup>nd</sup> June. Everything ready to go. Risk assessment done, Emma booked in for music, plenty of volunteers plus spares. Canteen will be open and glow sticks to be sold. Front gate sign in sheet will be in alphabetical order to make sign in/sign out easier. Students will be asked to bring in a gold coin donation for mini vinnies.

### Canteen
